

Indigenous Sign On Payment

- Agreement to undertake specific activities to improve care to ATSI patients with chronic condition(s)
- Part of COAG Closing the Gap Program
- \$1000 per practice
- Once-only payment



Sign on Agreement

- Agree to seek consent to register eligible patients for PIP and/or PBS Co-payment programs
- Ensure ATSI patients with chronic disease are followed up (recall)
- Undertake cultural awareness training within 12 months
 - 2 staff
 - At least 1 GP
 - Approved by RACGP/NACCHO National Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation
 - RACGP 6 hour training \$179 (free for RACGP members/GPs)



Cultural Awareness Training Exemptions



- 12 month grace period when practice has signed on to program
- Clinics under management of an Aboriginal board of directors or committee made up of Aboriginal community representatives
- If only 2 staff members at a practice, only 1 staff member requires training
- Staff member who qualifies as an Aboriginal Health Worker
- Temporary/locum GPs with tenure less than 6 month, provided at least 1 other staff member is trained





- Annotate scripts for patients registered with PBS Co-payment incentive
- Evidence of ATSI status NOT required – self identification
- RACGP Standards requirement
 - C7.1E (flagged) Our practice routinely records the Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander status of our patients in their patient health record

Patient Registration Payment

- CONSENT!
- \$250 per patient per year
- >15 years of age
- Chronic condition
- Offered ATSI Health Assessment (Item 715)
- Offered 70-707 for RACF residents
- Usual patient of the practice
- Annual re-registration | HPOS or fax





Patient Registration Criteria

- If registered Jan October
 - \$250 for year to 31 December
- If registered Nov-December
 - \$250 for current AND next year



MBS Program Eligibility





715 ATSI Health Assessment \$224.40

Eligible for 5 visits/year

- Aboriginal health worker or allied health
- Items 81300 81360
- > 20 minutes
- Specific referral required
- \$56.00

10987 Nurse follow up 10/year

• \$25.35



But wait...there's more!

If patient has GPMP/TCA

- 10997 Nurse follow up 5 per year \$12.70
- Allied health visits 5 per year (10950 – 10970)

Essentially DOUBLE service eligibility

Payment Tier 1

- Prepare a GPMP +/- TCA
- At least 1 review of GPMP or;
- At least 2 reviews of GPMP during calendar year
- \$100 per eligible patient



Indigenous
Health
Outcomes
Payment Tier 2

- Provision of majority of care to eligible patient
- Minimum 5 services per year
- \$150 per patient per calendar year

Don't Forget!

- Complete & retain patient consent form
- Send registration & consent form to Services Australia (proof of consent if registered through HPOS)
- Proof of systems in place to ensure patients are followed up
- Proof of cultural awareness training
- Confirmation statement | verify ongoing eligibility
- Advice changes to practice arrangements (HPOS, Change of Practice Details form IPO05, write to SA within 7 days (!)

Teaching Incentive



Payment for teaching medical students

Max 2 sessions per GP per day

\$200 per session

After Hours

- 5 levels of payment
- \$1 to \$11 per SWPE per year
- Service access
 - 6pm weeknights
 - 12pm Saturday
 - all day Sunday
 - public holidays
- Sociable after hours to 11pm weeknights



Rural Support Stream Incentives

- Rural loading \$
 - Based on RRMA classification 3-7
 - 15 50% loading on all PIP (but not SIP) items







Procedural GP

- Rural & remote areas
- Obstetric deliveries
- Anaesthetic general/major regional blocks
- Abdo/gyn surgery, endoscopy
- Not for minor procedures eg joint aspiration
- 4 tiers of service/payment
- \$1000 \$8500 per 6 months
